Re: NSPCC PANTS Talk for Year 2 Children - Wednesday 29th January 2025

We are writing to inform you about an important session that will be delivered to our Year 2 children by the school nurses on Wednesday 29th January 2025.

The session is part of the NSPCC's PANTS campaign, which helps children to understand that their bodies belong to them and empowers them to say no to any unwanted or inappropriate contact.

The PANTS talk is designed in a child-friendly and age-appropriate way, using the acronym PANTS to help children remember these key messages:

- P: Privates are private.
- A: Always remember your body belongs to you.
- N: No means no.
- T: Talk about secrets that upset you.
- S: Speak up, someone can help.

This session is a part of our ongoing commitment to safeguarding and educating our pupils about their rights to safety and respect. It will provide them with the knowledge and confidence to understand personal boundaries and to seek help if they ever feel uncomfortable.
